ELIGIBILITY

Target Group

All eligible Out of Home Care Leavers meeting the following conditions:

(Clauses 1.1 and 5.1(a)(i))

- Be aged between their 17th and 25th Birthdays and have been in Out of Home Care for at least 12 months (when they turn 25, they are no longer eligible for the program).
- Be living in or have left statutory care (foster, relative or kinship care of residential care settings) or Guardianship.
- Not be receiving assistance under the Premier's Youth Initiative (PYI).
- Be living in Mid North Coast DCJ District at the time they enter the FPS Pilot noting;
 - Once they are in FPS Pilot, they can move to another location outside the pilot area and continue to be supported under the pilot from their Future Coach or Intensive Caseworker (mentoring, advice, referrals, brokerage) during transition until they have established a support network elsewhere
 - They can move into the pilot area from another place and be eligible to start receiving FPS
 - If they are living in areas surrounding the pilot boundaries, they may be offered FPS on a case-by-case basis
 - If they are incarcerated, they may continue to receive support from their Future Coach or Intensive Caseworker through a local agreement with Justice NSW
